

IMPORTANT ADVISORY FOR INDIAN NATIONALS VISITING BRUSSELS

Attention of Indian diaspora is invited to recent incidents of Indian nationals being subjected to pick-pocketing, bag snatching and theft in Brussels.

All are advised to take care of their belongings, in particular, handbags, passports and travel documents, especially in crowded public areas like airports, railway/tram stations, shopping malls, hotel lobbies and places of tourist interests.

A report has been received of an incident where an Indian national was a victim of brutal stabbing in Brussels 1000 commune but fortunately survived the incident.

Members of Indian diaspora are advised to be cautiously vigilant to safeguard their belongings as well their personal security.
