The Embassy of India in Brussels is hosting a digital exhibition titled 'Human Cost of Terrorism' at the Chancery. The exhibition was formally inaugurated on 14 August 2025 by Ambassador Saurabh Kumar, in the presence of members of the media, officials of the Embassy, and invited guests.

The exhibition seeks to shed light on the profound and oftenoverlooked human toll of terrorism across the globe. Through a carefully curated timeline of major terrorist incidents affecting India and other nations, it underscores the universal threat posed by terrorism, encapsulated in the message: **'Terrorism anywhere is terrorism everywhere.'**

One of the focal points of the exhibition is the recent **dastardly cross-border terrorist attack in Pahalgam, India, in April 2025**, which claimed the lives of **26 innocent tourists**, targeted solely because of their faith. This tragic incident is presented as a stark reminder of the urgent need for united and unwavering global action against terrorism in all its forms and manifestations.

In addition to chronicling the grim history of terrorist violence, the exhibition features an **interactive section**, allowing visitors to explore the various measures undertaken by India and the international community to combat terrorism. It also invites reflection on what more can be done to ensure a consistent, principled, and cooperative approach in countering this scourge.

The digital exhibition will be open to the public from 18 to 22 August 2025, between 9:30 am - 12:30 pm and 2:30 pm - 5:30 pm at the Embassy premises (Chau. De Vleurgat 217, 1050 Brussels). All visitors are welcome to attend and engage with this important initiative that calls for a collective resolve against terrorism.
