PUBLIC NOTICE

Subject: Re-issuance of International Driving Permit (IDP) by the Missions from 15.02.2021-Regarding

Attention of all Indian Nationals holding **International Driving Permit (IDP)** in **Belgium & Luxembourg** are invited to above mentioned subject.

2. **The International Driving Permit (IDP)** which are valid for **ONE YEAR only** helps the Indian National to drive vehicle which is allowed to drive **as per Indian Driving Licence**, in **foreign country** which are the signatory of Geneva Convention on Road Traffic, 1949. The list of such countries also includes **Belgium and Luxembourg**.

2. The Mission, **w.e.f 15.02.2021**, will accept the consular application for **RE-ISSUANCE** of International Driving Permit (IDP) to Indian Nationals who are in **possession of the IDP along with valid domestic driving licence issued by the Government of India** on payment of prescribed Fees (EURO 12+ ICWF Charges EURO 2).

3. **The following procedures may be followed for Re-Issuance of the International Driving Permit (IDP):-**

- (i). Applicants will submit the Miscellaneous Service Form (<https://www.indianembassybrussels.gov.in/pages.php?id=27>) for Re-issuance of **International Driving Permit (IDP) with Consular Wing of the Embassy of India, Brussels**, at the **Appointed TIME**. The prior appointment may be sought by contacting the Consular Officials between 0930-1630 hrs on any working day at +32-26451865 or cons.brussels@mea.gov.in.
- (ii). **The Mission will issue a receipt** to the applicant with following details on it:-
 - (a). Name of the applicant as per Passport
 - (b). Expired IDP number of the applicant
 - (c). Consular officer certifying that applicant is the same as per passport photo on the expired IDP and is holding a valid domestic driving licence issued by Government of India.
 - (d). Receipt number will also be put on the receipt.
- (iii). Thereafter, applicant will apply for **fresh issue of International Driving Permit (IDP)** through the portal www.parivahan.gov.in and will upload the documents including the **RECEIPT** issued by the Mission as required under the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989.
- (iv). On receipt of online application through the portal (www.parivahan.gov.in), the licencing authority, on verification of the documents, shall issue the **International Driving Permit (IDP)** which shall courier it directly to the address of the applicants.
